

# NYS GOVERNOR'S PROPOSED FY 2021 – 2022 CCO FUNDING CUT



- The proposed effective funding cut date is 7 /1/21.
- The new cut is a 23% funding reduction and in addition to the 16.2% CCO/HH cut that went into effect last year on July 1, 2020 -166 million dollars (39%) will be cut from New York's disability care coordination budget leaving individuals with I/DD at high risk.
- If the proposed 23% funding cut for FY 2021 -2022 is approved (39% total cut over 2 budget cycles), CCO/HH care management services that individuals with I/DD receive are at risk.
- Like last year's 16.2% budget cut, this proposed cut is being done as an "administrative action" and is hidden from the public in the NYS budget documentation. No transparency in Governor's Executive budget.
- The impact of these new proposed cuts is alarming and creates significant concerns for the 110,000 individuals with I/DD and their families who rely on care management service delivery.
- We have not fully evaluated the impact of this latest cut and what this will mean for our ability as a CCO/HH to deliver what we do currently for our members.
